A RESOLUTION COMMENDING W. D. "BILL" OVERSTREET,
THE ALASKA COMMITTEE, AND THE PEOPLE OF JUNEAU
FOR THEIR CAMPAIGN AGAINST CAPITAL RELOCATION.

WHEREAS, on Tuesday, November 2nd, the people of the State of Alaska ended years of agonizing uncertainty by voting to keep their capital where it belongs - in the City and Borough of Juneau, and

WHEREAS, this victory was due to the sound judgment of Alaskan voters and the hard work of Juneau's defenders, and

WHEREAS, it is fitting that all who worked so hard to save our piece of Alaska should be commended;
