A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION SERIAL NO. 886 TO CHANGE THE METHOD OF COMPUTATION OF ROOM FEES FOR CATERED EVENTS IN CENTENNIAL HALL AND WAIVING FEES FOR CERTAIN USES FROM JUNE 11 THROUGH JUNE 19, 1983.

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that the Juneau Centennial Hall will be officially opened during the second week of April, and

WHEREAS, it would be appropriate to waive the room fees for admission free community uses during a week of operation in order to familiarize local groups with the facilities available, and

WHEREAS, the room rental fee for catered events should be changed to encourage rather than discourage catered events;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

- 1. That Resolution Serial No. 886 is amended by changing Paragraph 5(d) to read:
- (d) For any use which is catered or at which intoxicating beverages are served, the user shall be entitled to a rebate equal to the sum of 15% of the user food catering contract and 20% of the user liquor catering contract or the liquor sales made.
- 2. That for admission free community uses of Centennial Hall facilities between June 11 and June 19, 1983 no facility use fee shall be charged.
