A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND PUBLIC FACILITIES (DOTPF) PERMIT THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU TO ASSUME THE DEPARTMENT'S RESPONSIBILITIES RELATING TO THE DAVIS AVENUE WATERLINE PROJECT.

WHEREAS, DOTPF plans to construct the Davis Avenue Waterline Project, which is for a waterline to connect the Alaska State Correctional Facility at Lemon Creek with the water main of the city and borough, and

WHEREAS, AS 35.15.080 provides that a municipality may, upon the concurrence of the Commissioner of DOTPF, assume the department's planning and construction responsibilities for public works projects of the state which are located within the municipality, and

WHEREAS, the City and Borough of Juneau has the authority to receive and expend such funds and to contract for such work, and

WHEREAS, the City and Borough of Juneau desires to assume the department's responsibilities for the work;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BORUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

1. That, pursuant to AS 35.15.080, the Commissioner of the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities is requested to execute one or more agreements with the City and Borough of Juneau which provide for the assumption by the city and borough of the department's responsibilities relating to the work to be accomplished under the DOTPF Davis Avenue Waterline Project.

2. That upon the execution of an agreement, the city and borough shall assume responsibility for the administration of the subject project and the funds.

3. That the manager of the City and Borough of Juneau or his designee shall be the coordinator for the project. Further, the manager is authorized to execute necessary agreements and to do all things necessary to comply with the lawful

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requirements of the department, including, without limitation, the designation of a project coordinator.
