A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE OFFER OF GRANTS FROM
THE STATE OF ALASKA IN THE SUM OF \$10,284,400.

WHEREAS, pursuant to House Bill 105 and House Bill 309, the State of Alaska has appropriated to the City and Borough of Juneau the sum of \$10,284,400 for the below grants, and

WHEREAS, the City and Borough of Juneau is about to incur expenses in implementing the below grants, and

WHEREAS, the City and Borough of Juneau is willing to undertake the performance of these grants pursuant to AS 37.05.315;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

1. The City and Borough of Juneau accepts the grant offer of \$10,284,400 for the following grants:


