RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

A RESOLUTION PROHIBITING SMOKING IN THE  
ASSEMBLY CHAMBERS DURING PUBLIC MEETINGS.

WHEREAS, the Assembly Chambers of the City and Borough of Juneau are used for meetings of the Assembly, the Planning Commission, other municipal bodies, and

WHEREAS, smoking has been shown to be harmful not only to the health of smokers, but also to the health of non-smokers who are exposed to tobacco smoke, and

WHEREAS, public participation in public meetings is reduced when unhealthy and irritating conditions such as those created by smoking are permitted to occur during public meetings, and

WHEREAS, under AS 18.35.300(3) smoking is prohibited during state sponsored public meetings held in state owned or controlled buildings, and

WHEREAS, every effort should be made to encourage citizen participation in local public meetings;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:


1. That smoking of cigarettes, cigars and pipes in the Assembly Chambers during public meetings is prohibited except when the facility is rented.

2. That smoking shall be permitted in the hall and common areas adjacent to the Assembly Chambers.

3. That the manager shall post appropriate signs to implement this resolution.

4. That Resolution Serial No. 630 is repealed.
