WHEREAS, annually the city and borough prepares a comprehensive capital improvement program for Juneau, and

WHEREAS, some needed local projects are beyond the capacity of the local government to fund and/or are appropriate for state funding through state-wide programs, and

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska prepares and implements an annuual capital improvement program and provides funds to local governments to implement some locally requested projects, and

WHEREAS, Governor Sheffield has requested that all communities submit their capital project priorities to the appropriate state departments and agencies for consideration for state funding, and

WHEREAS, the City and Borough of Juneau Assembly has conducted public meetings and hearings, a broad citizen survey, and numerous studies to determine local priorities;
