A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION SERIAL NO. 963 TO MAKE PROVISION OF WATER SERVICE CONTINGENT UPON PAYMENT OF ALL WATER ASSESSMENTS, CHARGES, AND FEES

WHEREAS, present policies allow the municipality to refuse water service until all assessments, charges, and fees due and payable under Resolution No. 963 have been paid, and

WHEREAS, property is sometimes burdened by municipal water service obligations imposed other than by Resolution 963, and

WHEREAS, enforcement procedures should be available for such obligations;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the assembly of the city and borough of Juneau, Alaska that paragraph 1(D)(1) is amended to read:

Except for the initial turn-on that occurs when property is first connected to the municipal water system, each customer or applicant for service shall pay a fee of \$20 for turning on or turning off the water service to the property. The fee shall be paid for each turn-on and turn-off whether at the customer's or applicant's request or due to nonpayment for water services. The water service to a property may not be turned on unless all assessments, charges, and fees due and payable under this or any other resolution, ordinance, or agreement pertaining to the installation of the water system or the provision of water service have been paid without regard to the ownership of the property at the time such assessments, fees, or charges arose. Payment of assessments, charges, or fees by a person other than the person who owned the property at the time the assessments, charges, or fees arose constitutes an assignment by the city and borough to the person making payment of all rights of the city and borough to the collection of such amounts from the person who owned the property at the time such assessments, charges, or fees were imposed.
