

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

A RESOLUTION CALLING A SPECIAL ELECTION TO ASK FOR
VOTER APPROVAL OF THE AIRPORT TERMINAL EXPANSION PROJECT
SO THAT CERTAIN STATE FUNDS MAY BE USED IN THE PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the terminal building at the Juneau International Airport is inadequate to meet the needs of Alaska's capital city, and

WHEREAS, the city and borough of Juneau plans a \$9.3 expansion of the terminal, and

WHEREAS, such expansion will be funded by local funds, federal funds, and state funds, including \$3.5 million in state funds under Chapter 60 S.L.A 1981 S.B. 168, and

WHEREAS, prior to the expenditure of Chapter 60 S.L.A. 1981 funds for expansion projects costing a total of more than \$5 million, voter approval of the project must be secured, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

1. That the question of whether or not the voters of the City and Borough of Juneau, Alaska approve the airport terminal building expansion project shall be submitted to the qualified voters of the city and borough of Juneau at a special municipal election to be held on January 24, 1984; and that the city and borough clerk shall take all steps necessary in accordance with law and the Charter of the city and borough to place said question before the qualified voters at said election.

2. That the question to be submitted to the qualified voters at said election shall read substantially as follows:

APPROVAL OF AIRPORT TERMINAL EXPANSION PROJECT

The City and Borough plans a \$9.3 million expansion project for the Juneau Airport terminal building. Most of the funds are from state and federal grants. One state grant of \$3.5 million requires that the voters of the municipality approve the project before those state grant funds are used. Approval of this proposition will insure that the planned terminal expansion can get underway this year. Disapproval of the proposition will delay the project and make it necessary to either redesign and reduce the scope of the improvements or take funding from other projects, or both.


AIRPORT TERMINAL BUILDING EXPANSION APPROVAL
