RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE STATE OF ALASKA TO ACCEPT THE TRANSFER OF THE JUNEAU INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT TO THE STATE OF ALASKA.

WHEREAS, the Civil Aeronautics Administration conveyed the bulk of the property that constitutes the Juneau International Airport to the City of Juneau in 1953, and

WHEREAS, the City of Juneau and the City and Borough of Juneau have since that date acquired additional property for the airport, and

WHEREAS, air transportation is a statewide concern and should be a state responsibility, and

WHEREAS, support of airport operations and improvements should be from statewide funds rather than from local funds;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

That the Governor of the state of Alaska is urged to direct the appropriate department of the state of Alaska to commence negotiations with the city and borough, such negotiations to cover the possibility of the transfer and assignment to the state of the assets and liabilities of the Juneau International Airport, and such additional topics as future improvements to the airport, the scheduling of such improvements, state support for the airport operation and other matters directed by the assembly.
