RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION SERIAL NO. 963
TO ESTABLISH A REDUCED WATER RATE FOR CERTAIN INDUSTRIAL USERS.

WHEREAS, certain industrial uses require substantial quantities of water, and

WHEREAS, the availability and cost of water can have a significant impact on the decision to establish a new industrial use in Juneau, and

WHEREAS, the city and borough should encourage the establishment of new commercial and industrial uses within the City and Borough of Juneau that will diversify or strengthen its economy, and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate to provide an incentive to such commercial or industrial pursuits where said commercial or industrial pursuits could be as easily located in Juneau as elsewhere;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU. ALASKA:

1. That Resolution Serial No. 963, as amended by Resolution Serial Nos. 978, and 998(rev.) is further amended by changing paragraph 1F(1) to read:

(1) Metered Water Service.

- (a) Except as provided in paragraph (b), the monthly charge for first 4,000 gallons or any part thereof is \$13.00; for each 1,000 gallons, rounded to the nearest 1,000 gallons, in excess of 4,000, an additional charge of \$1.50 shall be paid.
- (b) Upon a determination by the manager that a new commercial or industrial user that could be as easily located in Juneau as elsewhere, such as a fish processing plant, will probably require in excess of 18,000,000 gallons per year, such user may be provided water for a monthly charge of \$0.50 per 1,000 gallons for the first 2,000,000 gallons per month and \$1.00 per 1,000 gallons for consumption over 2,000,000 gallons per month.
- * Section 2. Effective Date. This resolution shall be effective from January 1, 1984.
