RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

A RESOLUTION CHANGING THE REGULAR ASSEMBLY MEETINGS OF SEPTEMBER FROM THE FIRST AND THIRD MONDAYS IN THE MONTH TO THE SECOND AND THIRD MONDAYS IN THE MONTH.

WHEREAS, the assembly, by Resolution No. 788, as amended by Resolution No. 1018 has established the first and third Mondays of each month as the dates for its regular meetings, and

WHEREAS, the first Monday of September of each year falls on Labor Day, and

WHEREAS, it would be in the public interest for the assembly to reschedule the first meeting in September to a date that does not fall on a holiday;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

That Rule 2A of paragraph 1 of Resolution 788, as amended by Resolution 1018, is amended to read:

A. The assembly shall regularly meet on the first and third Monday of each month at 7:30 P.M.; except, it shall meet on the second and third Mondays in the month of September.
