RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

A RESOLUTION CALLING FOR AN ADVISORY PROPOSITION ON WHETHER THE ASSEMBLY SHOULD CONSIDER THE SALE OF THE BARTLETT MEMORIAL HOSPITAL.

WHEREAS, the Board of the Bartlett Memorial Hospital has determine that a need exists for the expansion of the hospital, and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that such expansion will probably cost about \$20 million, and

WHEREAS, all or a substantial part of the cost of the expansion will probably come from locally generated revenues or from the allocation of state monies that might otherwise be used for other municipal projects, and

WHEREAS, it has been suggested that the cost of expansion of the hospital could be avoided by the sale of the hospital to a private organization, and

WHEREAS, before the assembly considers the options available to it in meeting the expansion needs of the hospital, it would be appropriate to ask the voters in the city and borough whether the assembly should even consider the sale of the hospital as an option for meeting the expansion needs;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

That the Clerk of the City and Borough of Juneau, Alaska place before the voters at the regular municipal election to be held on October 2, 1984 an advisory proposition reading substantially as follows:

Advisory Proposition on Sale of Hospital

Explanation of Proposition

The Bartlett Memorial Hospital must be expanded in the near future. The cost of the expansion may be as much as \$20 million. This cost could be met through a combination of

state grants, local taxes, donations, and municipal bonds. Instead of undertaking the expansion itself, the municipality could sell the hospital to private enterprise in the hope that the new owner would undertake the necessary expansion. Before the assembly considers the alternatives it has, it would like to know whether you believe it should even consider the sale of the hospital as an alternative.
