RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

Serial No. 1056

A RESOLUTION CALLING FOR AN ADVISORY PROPOSITION ON THE QUESTION OF WHETHER THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU SHOULD PROVIDE POLICE PROTECTION TO AREAS NOT CURRENTLY SERVED.

WHEREAS, the full scope of police protection is provided only within the Juneau and Douglas Service Areas, and

WHEREAS, the bulk of the population resides outside these two areas, and

WHEREAS, the increasing concentration of population outside the Juneau and Douglas Service Areas brings with it an increasing need for police protection, and

WHEREAS, an ad hoc committee established by the assembly to review the need for areawide police protection has submitted to the assembly its report recommending that enforcement activities be increased in the areas outside the Juneau and Douglas Service Areas, and

WHEREAS, citizens residing in the area outside the Juneau and Douglas Service Areas have submitted a petition requesting the extension of police protection;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

1. That the Clerk of the City and Borough of Juneau, Alaska place before the voters at the regular municipal election to be held on October 2, 1984 an advisory proposition reading substantially as follows:

Advisory Proposition on the Extension of Police Protection.

Explanation of Proposition

In its May 1984 report to the assembly, the Advisory Committee on Areawide Police estimated an additional annual cost of \$1.4 to \$2.3 million to provide areawide police coverage. The proposed millage rates range from 1.1 to 3.6 mills depending upon the service area and level of police service. (One mill on a \$100,000 home is \$100.)


