RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING AN AD HOC EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS
PLAN REVISION COMMITTEE FOR THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU.

WHEREAS, the City and Borough of Juneau adopted an Emergency Preparedness Plan in 1974 and has not updated it since then, and

WHEREAS, the demographics and development patterns of this community have changed significantly since the last plan was prepared, thereby necessitating changes in shelter and transportation contingency plans, and

WHEREAS, Juneau's geography, geology and distance from food, fuel and other essential supplies, may make Juneau vulnerable in certain disaster situations, and

WHEREAS, the State Division of Emergency Services, Department of Military Affairs and the Federal Emergency Management Agency are willing to give assistance to such an effort, and


WHEREAS, the people of Juneau have expressed an interest in and willingness to begin participating in rewriting this plan;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

That the ad hoc Juneau Emergency Preparedness Plan Revision Committee is created consisting of such number of members as are appointed by the assembly. The committee shall review the existing plan, hold public hearings, work with the various state, federal, and local public and private agencies which have expertise in this area. The committee will report back to the assembly by March 1, 1985 recommending changes and additions to the plan and

recommending to the assembly a Revised Emergency Preparedness Plan. Unless the life of the committee is extended by the assembly by motion, the committee shall dissolve on April 30, 1985.
