RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

A RESOLUTION HONORING THE JUNEAU POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR THEIR EFFORTS IN APPREHENDING AN ESCAPED PRISONER AND HER ACCOMPLICE.

WHEREAS, a United States marshal informed the Juneau Police Department on July 18, 1984 that an escaped federal prisoner and her accomplice may be in the Southeast Alaska vicinity, and

WHEREAS, the wanted subject had successfully escaped confinement three times, had attempted to escape eight times, and the last escape took place on May 26, 1982 from the Michigan State Corrections Institution while she was serving two life sentences for two counts of first degree murder, plus eight to ten years for attempted murder, and

WHEREAS, the escaped federal prisoner was accompanied by an accomplice, who was believed to have aided in the escape while employed as a vocational instructor at the prison from which the escapee had been incarerated, and

WHEREAS, on July 18, 1984 the U. S. marshal requested Juneau Police Department assistance in apprehending the two fugitives who were residing in a home in the downtown Juneau area. On July 19, 1984 at approximately 8:57 a.m. the escapee's companion and accomplice was apprehended, and at 10:17 a.m. the escaped federal prisoner was arrested, both without incident;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

That the Juneau Police Department is to be commended for the expeditious and efficient manner in which they apprehended the extremely dangerous fugitives. Adopted this 15th day of October, 1984.
