RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

A RESOLUTION COMMENDING THE U.S. ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS AND THE SOUTHEAST REGION OF THE ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND PUBLIC FACILITIES FOR THEIR WORK ON THE DRAFT ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT STATEMENT FOR THE PROPOSED AUKE BAY FLOATING BREAKWATER AND TRANSIENT MOORAGE; URGING THE CORPS TO PROCEED AS RAPIDLY AS POSSIBLE WITH THE FINAL ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT STATEMENT; AND SELECTING THE 260 BOAT ALTERNATIVE AS THE MOST PREFERABLE OPTION.

WHEREAS, the proposed Auke Bay Floating Breakwater and Transient Moorage development is the subject of a draft environmental impact statement produced by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers and the Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities that was published in September of 1984, and

WHEREAS, the area proposed for the development is specifically designed for such use in the recently adopted Juneau Comprehensive Plan, and

WHEREAS, the Draft Environmental Impact Statement addresses all the subjects appropriate to its purpose although minor technical matters need further attention, and

WHEREAS, the document shows that negative environmental impacts will be minimal and will be greatly outweighed by the positive public benefits to be gained, and

WHEREAS, environmental benefits will be gained from the project as well, and

WHEREAS, the floating breakwater and transient moorage are essential to the continued, rational growth of the City and Borough of Juneau;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

1. That the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers and the Southeast Region of the Alaska Department of Transportation

and Public Facilities are commended on their excellent work in producing the Draft Environmental Impact Statement for the proposed Auke Bay Floating Breakwater and Transient Moorage project.

- 2. That the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers is urged to move expeditiously to produce the Final Environmental Impact Statement for the project.
- 3. That the Assembly of the City and Borough of Juneau endorses the Planning Commission recommendation of the 260 boat proposal as the preferable alternative.
