RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

A RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE MANAGER TO PREPARE
A REPORT ON THE PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT AND
MANAGEMENT OF A JUNEAU BEACH PARK SYSTEM.

WHEREAS, the assembly in 1975 received a Beach Parks for Juneau report from a volunteer group of citizens, and

WHEREAS, the assembly in 1984 received a proposal from the Taku Conservation Society to establish a capital city beach park system, and

WHEREAS, the Comprehensive Plan for the City and Borough of Juneau and the Juneau Area Recreation Plan both address the need for the establishment of beach parks, and

WHEREAS, the Parks and Recreation Advisory Committee supports the establishment of a beach park system;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

1. That the manager is directed to prepare a report on the physical development and management of a Juneau beach park system.

2. That the report shall include a review of possible land management strategies for a beach park system.

3. That the report shall include a development plan listing priorities, levels of development, and potential development costs for a beach park system.

4. That the report shall address beaches accessible by road and otherwise.

5. That other public agencies be encouraged to participate in the beach park system report.

6. That the report shall be completed on or before October 7, 1986.
