A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE CONCEPT OF A YOUTH CRIME PREVENTION PROGRAM BY THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU BOARD OF EDUCATION AND THE JUNEAU POLICE DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, representatives of the City and Borough of Juneau School District and the Juneau Police Department have been seeking ways to improve our efforts at crime prevention, and

WHEREAS, the incidence of juvenile crime in the City and Borough of Juneau is sufficient to warrant new and unique methods of prevention, and

WHEREAS, there has been considerable discussion between the school district staff and the Juneau Police Department about a youth officer program as a means of crime prevention, and

WHEREAS, the school district and police department have been notified that matching funds authorized through the Juvenile Assistance Block Grant Funds are available for support of such a program, and

WHEREAS, the City and Borough of Juneau School District and the Assembly would be required to commit matching funds for two years of such a program if application is made and subsequently approved, and

WHEREAS, the municipality's share of a two year commitment to the proposed Youth Crime Prevention Program would be \$30,000;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

That the Assembly supports the proposed Youth Officer Program and if a grant award is offered will consider an appropriation ordinance as soon as practical to provide its share of matching funds for Youth Crime Prevention Program at a level not to exceed \$30,000 for a two year period. Adopted this 5th day of August, 1985.
