RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

A RESOLUTION URGING THE STATE TO UNDERTAKE IMPROVEMENTS IN FERRY, ROAD, AND AIR TRANSPORTATION SYSTEMS.

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska has developed a draft Southeast Alaska Transportation Plan, and

WHEREAS, the City and Borough of Juneau is well situated to become a regional transportation center, and

WHEREAS, various programs and projects are needed to enhance the transportation systems in northern southeast Alaska;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

- 1. That Juneau be designated as the northern terminus of the mainline ferry system.
- 2. That all northbound mainline ferries continue to Sitka and return to Juneau to begin their southern voyage.
- 3. That mainline ferries connect with "fast" ferries in Juneau to efficiently complete service routes further north.
- 4. That phased construction of a road north from Juneau begin immediately and that said construction continue until the road can replace the northern leg of the ferry system.
- 5. That microwave navigational equipment be placed at the Juneau International Airport.
- 6. That the state study the development alternate runway alignments, locations, or both, for improving efficiencies of landing at Juneau during adverse weather conditions.
