NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

That Rule 4B of the Assembly's Rules of Procedure as set out in Resolution Serial No. 1136, as amended by Resolutions Serial No. 1151 and 1175, is amended to read:

B. Selection of Committees. Any person qualified to vote under Section 6.3 of the Charter shall be eligible for voting committee membership. Committee appointments shall be nominated by the Committee on Committees but are subject to ratification by a majority of the members of the Assembly.
