A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE FEE FOR IMPOUNDMENT OF LIVESTOCK.

WHEREAS, it is in the interest of municipal health, safety, and welfare that livestock be impounded for violations of the animal control code when deemed necessary by animal control officers within the city and borough, and

WHEREAS, the impoundment, transportation, and boarding of livestock is very expensive, and

WHEREAS, the owners of impounded livestock should bear the costs of impoundment of their livestock;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

- 1. The fee for impoundment of livestock is one hundred dollars (\$100) per animal plus transportation and boarding costs.
- (a) The owner of the impounded livestock must pay the above-referenced fee as a condition of regaining custody of the livestock.
- (b) Livestock as used hereinabove means cattle, swine, goats, sheep, horses, donkeys, and mules.
- 2. Effective Date. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
