WHEREAS, the Assembly has determined that Resolution Serial No. 1216 should be amended so as to establish the city and borough's top priority for state loan programs for Fiscal Year 1988;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:
