RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MANAGER TO TRANSFER FIVE SURPLUS POLE STREET LIGHTS TO THE STATE OF ALASKA, DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND PUBLIC FACILITIES.

WHEREAS, Section 53.50.220 of the city and borough code requires Assembly approval by resolution prior to a transfer to another governmental unit of any surplus city and borough supplies with an estimated value of greater than two hundred dollars, and

WHEREAS, the City and Borough of Juneau International Airport has five tapered aluminum pole street lights that are surplus to the needs of the city and borough, and

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska, Department of Transportation and Public Facilities, has requested that these surplus street lights be transferred to it for use in the Juneau area, and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the estimated maximum value of the five surplus street lights is \$500, and

WHEREAS, the surplus street lights were originally purchased for Yandukin Drive by the State of Alaska with Federal Highway Administration funds, and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the best interests of the public would be served by this transfer, for no cost, of surplus property to the State of Alaska;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

1. That the manager is authorized to transfer five surplus tapered aluminum pole street lights with arched arm and mercury vapor fixtures to the State of Alaska, Department of Transportation and Public Utilities, for no cost.

2. That the city and borough shall not be responsible for any costs or expenses associated with the transfer to the State of Alaska.

3. Effective Date. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
