A RESOLUTION COMMENDING MARGARET (PEGGY) LIND FOR HER CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE CITY AND BOROUGH BY HER SERVICE AS A MEMBER AND AS CHAIRPERSON OF THE PARKS AND RECREATION COMMITTEE.

WHEREAS, Peggy Lind was appointed to the Parks and Recreation Committee in 1967 and has been Chairperson of the Committee since June, 1970; and

WHEREAS, she has resigned from the Committee as a consequence of her family being transferred to Baton Rouge, Louisiana; and
