A RESOLUTION URGING THE U. S. CORPS OF ENGINEERS AND THE U. S. FOREST SERVICE TO TAKE ALL STEPS NECESSARY TO ENSURE DEPENDABLE POWER TRANSMISSION FROM SNETTISHAM BY THE END OF THE 1975 CONSTRUCTION SEASON.

WHEREAS, dependable electric power is a necessity of life, particularly during winter, in Southeastern Alaska; and

WHEREAS, a continuation of the recent experience of frequent interruptions of power transmitted from the Snettisham power project to the City and Borough of Juneau for another winter would be highly disruptive and dangerous to the health and welfare of the people of the City and Borough of Juneau;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:


That the U. S. Corps of Engineers and the U. S. Forest Service are strongly urged to do all things necessary to ensure dependable transmission of electric power from Snettisham by the end of the 1975 construction season.
