A RESOLUTION ADOPTING RULES OF PROCEDURE BY  
AND BEFORE THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU  
EMPLOYEE RELATIONS BOARD.

WHEREAS, a City and Borough of Juneau employee relations board was created by the Labor Relations Ordinance of the city and borough, CBJ 44.10, and

WHEREAS, said ordinance contemplates that the board will play a vital role in certain employee organization and collective bargaining procedures, and

WHEREAS, it is to the benefit of all parties involved if procedural rules can be established prior to the initiation of any collective bargaining activities, and

WHEREAS, the board, pursuant to CBJ 44.10.030(5) has proposed rules and regulations necessary to effectuate the purposes of the labor relations ordinance;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF  
THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU:

That those rules and regulations entitled RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU EMPLOYEE RELATIONS BOARD, dated June 5, 1975 and which are attached hereto as Exhibit A and made a part hereof, are hereby adopted as the rules and regulations of the City and Borough of Juneau Employee Relations Board.
