RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING THE TIME AND
PLACE FOR COUNTING ACCEPTED CHALLENGED
BALLOTS AND ABSENTEE BALLOTS CAST IN
THE SPECIAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON
SEPTEMBER 2, 1975 AND THE REGULAR
ELECTION TO BE HELD OCTOBER 7, 1975

WHEREAS, CBJ 29.05.200 provides that accepted
challenged ballots and absentee ballots shall be counted by
the City and Borough election official and two or more assis-
tants appointed by him; and

WHEREAS, said section further provides that such
counting shall be done prior to the convening of the canvass
board at a time and place designated by the Assembly by resolu-
tion and shall be accomplished in public in full view of any
persons assembled; and

WHEREAS, a special election is to be held on Sep-
tember 2, 1975; and

WHEREAS, a regular municipal election is to be held
October 7, 1975;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF
THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

1. That absentee ballots received in each election
prior to the close of the polls shall be counted as provided
by ordinance by the City and Borough election official at the
Assembly chambers in the Municipal Building, 155 South Seward
Street, commencing at the time the polls close.

2. That the accepted challenged ballots and the
absentee ballots cast, but not previously counted, in the
special election to be held on September 2, 1975 shall be
counted as provided by ordinance by the City and Borough
election officials at the Assembly chambers in the Municipal
Building, 155 South Seward Street, commencing at 1:00 p.m. on
September 9, 1975.

3. That the accepted challenged ballots and the absentee ballots cast, but not previously counted, in the regular election to be held on October 7, 1975 shall be counted as provided by ordinance by the City and Borough election officials at the Assembly chambers in the Municipal Building, 155 South Seward Street, commencing at 1:00 p.m. on October 13, 1975.
