A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE LEASE OF A PORTION OF A.T.S. NO. 556, TRACT A TO MIDNIGHTSUN BROADCASTERS, INC. FOR A PERIOD OF FIVE YEARS WITH AN OPTION TO RENEW FOR FIVE YEARS.

WHEREAS, Midnightsun Broadcasters, Inc. has applied for a five-year lease of certain tidelands with an option to renew for an additional five years, and

WHEREAS, the fair market value for this site has been established as \$96.00 per year, and

WHEREAS, such lot is presently undeveloped and available for leasing, and
