RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

A RESOLUTION CONCURRING WITH THE PROPOSED
FACILITIES PLAN FOR LEMON CREEK SEWER
SYSTEM DESIGNATED AS ALTERNATE NO. 2.

WHEREAS, the existing Mendenhall and Juneau-Douglas Sewage Treatment Plants have been designated as regional treatment facilities; and

WHEREAS, flows at the Mendenhall Sewage Treatment Plant exceed the design capacity of the plant; and

WHEREAS, the area between Juneau Service Area (No. 1) and the Mendenhall Valley is not currently served by the regional treatment facilities; and

WHEREAS, the City and Borough of Juneau possesses the necessary legal, financial, institutional, and managerial resources to construct, operate and maintain sewage treatment works and related facilities; and

WHEREAS, the recently completed Facilities Plan for Lemon Creek Sewer System, prepared in accordance with the Final Construction Grant Regulations, 40 CFR, Part 35, Subpart E, dated February 11, 1974, recommends certain improvements to the Mendenhall Treatment Plant and an expansion of existing sewer systems to serve the area between Service Area No. 1 and the Mendenhall Valley;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU:


That it hereby indicates its concurrence with the proposed plan designated as Alternate No. 2 in the referenced facilities plan and the City and Borough's intent to construct, operate, and maintain such proposed facilities in accordance with State and Federal requirements, if said facilities are approved and funded by the State and the U. S. Environmental Protection Agency and if local improvement districts formed to finance all or part of the local share of the costs of the improvements are not effectively rejected by the owners of property in such district.
