RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SCHOOL
DISTRICT OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU,
ALASKA TO ENTER INTO DEFERRED COMPENSATION
AGREEMENTS WITH DISTRICT EMPLOYEES.

WHEREAS, A.S. 39.45.010 authorizes political subdivisions of the state to enter into agreements with employees to defer, in whole or in part, employees salaries or wages, and

WHEREAS, the board of the school district of the city and borough of Juneau has approved a plan for such deferred compensation, and


WHEREAS, it appears that under Article X, Section 2 of the State of Alaska, and Title 29 of the Alaska Statutes a school district is not a political subdivision of the state,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

1. In accordance with A.S. 39.50.010 et seq, the school board of the city and borough of Juneau, Alaska is hereby authorized to enter into deferred compensation agreements with those employees of the city and borough of Juneau, a political subdivision of the state of Alaska, who are employed directly or indirectly by the school board or the superintendent of schools.

2. That all burdens and liabilities arising out of any deferred compensation plan approved by the school board and of any deferred compensation agreement entered into under the authority herein granted to the school board shall be the budgetary responsibility of the school district.
