RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

A RESOLUTION SETTING A TIME AND PLACE FOR A HEARING ON THE TERMINATION OF L.I.D. NO. 4 AND THE ABANDONMENT OF ALL PROPOSED ACQUISITION, CONSTRUCTION, IMPROVEMENTS, AND ASSESSMENTS THEREFOR.

WHEREAS, the assembly by Ordinance Serial No. 73-8 adopted May 3, 1973, as amended by Ordinance Serial No. 73-22 adopted May 3, 1973, created L.I.D. No. 4 for the purpose of providing a sewer system between Vanderbilt Hill and the City of Juneau, and

WHEREAS, events have occurred since the formation of the L.I.D. which have made the original plans unsuitable, and

WHEREAS, the assembly has considered three alternate facilities plans for the Lemon Creek Sewer System which take into account the current circumstances, and

WHEREAS, Alternate 2 of the Facilities Plan has been adopted by the assembly and has been approved by the Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation and the Federal Environmental Protection Agency, and

WHEREAS, the boundaries of L.I.D. No. 4 are no longer appropriate for the improvements planned under Alternate 2, and

WHEREAS, CBJ 15.10.080 requires a hearing be held before the boundaries of an L.I.D. are changed and before a planned improvement is abandoned,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

1. That a public hearing be held on September 2, 1976 at 8:00 p.m. at the Assembly Chambers, 155 South Seward street, Juneau on the adoption of an ordinance terminating L.I.D. No. 4 and abandoning all proposals for acquisition, construction, improvements and assessments therefor.

2. Notice of the hearing shall be given in accordance with CBJ 15.10.080.
