A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A GRANT FROM
THE STATE OF ALASKA FOR THE PURPOSE
OF CONDUCTING A JUNEAU HISTORIC SURVEY.

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska has offered to enter into a grant agreement for the Juneau Historic Survey Project, 02-76-00035-00, and

WHEREAS, under said grant agreement, the State agrees to make application to the federal government for funds to reimburse the City and Borough for not more than fifty percent of the cost of performing the survey, and


WHEREAS, it is anticipated that the survey will cost approximately \$10,000, and

WHEREAS, such survey will be beneficial to the City and Borough and should be undertaken,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

1. That the grant offer by the State is hereby accepted.
2. That the manager is hereby authorized to do all acts necessary to execute and carry out the terms of the agreement, to requisition all funds to which the City and Borough is entitled under the grant agreement, to make reports, provide records and documentation necessary to verify expenses and do such other acts as may be reasonably required by the State of Alaska under said agreement.
