That the U.S. Senate is urged to pass H. R. 9719 or similar Senate legislation, S. 3468, both of which have been endorsed by the National Association of Counties as an equitable and easily administered payments-in-lieu system, and that a copy of this resolution be forwarded to the Honorable Ted Stevens, U.S. Senator from Alaska; the Honorable Mike Gravel, U.S. Senator from Alaska; and the Honorable Don Young, U.S. Congressman from Alaska.
