A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 32 TO CHANGE THE MAKEUP OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU COMPREHENSIVE HEALTH PLANNING ADVISORY COUNCIL.

WHEREAS, the assembly created The City and Borough of Juneau Comprehensive Health Planning Advisory Council by Resolution No. 32, and

WHEREAS, said council consists of 21 members, a majority of which must be consumers, and

WHEREAS, experience has shown that the council should be changed to a more workable makeup;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

That paragraph 4 of Resolution No. 32 is amended to read as follows:

4. There shall be 12 members of the council who shall be appointed by the assembly. The council shall include representatives of major public and volunteer institutions and agencies concerned with the delivery of health services. No less than 4 members shall be consumers of health services broadly reflecting geographic, socioeconomic and ethnic groups in the area. No person whose major occupation is administration or financing of health activities shall be considered a consumer representative. No less than 4 members shall be representatives of health care providers.
