RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

A RESOLUTION CREATING A JUNEAU CENTENNIAL COMMITTEE.

WHEREAS, the townsite of what was later to become the City of Juneau was originally staked and settled in 1880, and

WHEREAS, the city and borough of Juneau, as successor to the City of Juneau, should celebrate and commemorate the 100th anniversary of the founding of its name-sake, and

WHEREAS, such commemorative celebration should have widespread community input, and

WHEREAS, planning and preparation for such a commemorative celebration should commence well in advance of the celebration;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

1. That there is hereby created the Juneau Centennial Committee.
2. That the committee shall consist of eleven persons, appointed by the assembly, whose terms shall last until December 31, 1980.
3. That the committee solicit public input and make recommendations to the assembly from time to time on the means and the method by which the community should commemorate and celebrate its 100th anniversary.
4. That the committee, with the approval of the assembly, coordinate and manage the Juneau centennial commemorative celebration activities.
5. That the committee receive, for its own use, such gifts, donations, contributions, grants and reimbursements as are appropriate to its function and purpose.
6. That the committee perform such additional relevant duties as the assembly may assign to it by motion or otherwise.
