RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

A RESOLUTION AMENDING PERSONNEL RULE
10 06.2 TO EXTEND MILITARY LEAVE RIGHTS TO
MEMBERS OF AN AUXILIARY OF THE ARMED FORCES
AND EXPANDING MILITARY LEAVE TO INCLUDE
CERTAIN SEARCH AND RESCUE ACTIVITIES.

WHEREAS, Alaska Statute 39.20.340(a) was amended by Chapter 49 (SLA 1976) to make military leave available to state and municipal employees who are members of an auxiliary reserve and auxiliary members when such employees are under direct military control in the performance of a search and rescue mission, effective August 1, 1976, and

WHEREAS, the right of municipal employees to such military leave is contingent upon the approval of the assembly, and

WHEREAS, Personnel Rule 10 06.2 provides for other activities of reserve members which qualify for military leave, and

WHEREAS, the leave policy of the city and borough should be similar to that of competing public employers;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

That Personnel Rule 10 06.2 is hereby amended to read as follows:

10.06.2 An employee who is a member of a reserve or auxiliary component of the United States Armed Forces is entitled to a leave of absence without loss of pay, during which he or she is ordered to training duty, as distinguished from active duty, with troops or at field exercises, or for instructions, or when under direct military control in the performance of a search and rescue mission. The leave of absence may not exceed 16 1/2 working days in any one calendar year.
