RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

A RESOLUTION DECLARING ASSEMBLY INTENT
RELATING TO THE USE OF THE PROCEEDS OF A TWO
PERCENT NON-AREAWIDE SERVICE AREA SALES TAX.

WHEREAS, Ordinance 77-01 which calls for a 2% sales tax levy in the rural Non-Areawide Service Area (No. 3) has been advanced to public hearing, and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 77-01, if passed by the assembly requires a proposition be submitted to the qualified voters of the Non-Areawide Service Area (No. 3) on the levy, and

WHEREAS, the assembly's basic intent through Ordinance 77-01 is to provide tax relief to the rural property owner by supplanting property taxes by the amount of additional sales tax revenue, and

WHEREAS, the assembly also views as desirable the secondary benefit of the sales tax increase inasmuch as it causes the sales tax throughout the city and borough of Juneau to be uniform thereby eliminating unfair business advantage to a particular area;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

That it is the intent of the assembly, should the proposition to the voters called for in Ordinance 77-01 be approved, to supplant property tax revenue with such additional sales tax revenue so as to reduce the tax burden on property owners in the Non-Areawide Service Area (No. 3.).
