RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

A RESOLUTION CONSOLIDATING RESOLUTIONS NO.
224, 225, 242 AND 287 AND REGARDING THE FARE
STRUCTURE OF THE CAPITAL TRANSIT SYSTEM AND
PROVIDING FOR TEMPORARY EXPERIMENTAL FARES.

WHEREAS, the assembly, by Resolutions No. 224,
225, 242 and 287 established zones and rates for the Capital
Transit System, and

WHEREAS, the various resolutions should be con-
solidated into one resolution for more efficient reference,
and

WHEREAS, from time to time suggestions are made
for improving the services and utilization of the Capital
Transit System, and

WHEREAS, a short period of experimentation utiliz-
ing suggested improvements would be helpful in evaluating
the desirability of a permanent change;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF
THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

1. That the following rates are hereby established
for the Capital Transit System:

A. Three zones shall be established as follows:

- (1) Zone 1 - From the end of scheduled
service on Glacier Highway to the Auke
Bay Post Office.
- (2) Zone 2 - From the Auke Bay Post Office
to the Highway complex located at
approximately Mile 7.3 on the Glacier
Highway.
- (3) Zone 3 - From the Highway complex
located at approximately Mile 7.3 on
the Glacier Highway to end of sche-
duled service.

B. The single-zone fare shall be thirty-five
cents (\$0.35), or one token, for each zone or
portion thereof.

C. Tokens may be sold at the following rates:

- (1) Three (3) tokens for ninety cents (\$0.90).
- (2) Seven (7) tokens for two dollars (\$2.00).
- (3) Forty (40) tokens for ten dollars (\$10.00).

D. No charge will be made for:

- (1) Persons over 65 years of age provided that a pass issued by the city and borough is displayed to the bus driver.
- (2) Pre-school children when accompanied by a fare-paying passenger.

E. The purchase price for a pass which may be issued only to or used by a student is ten dollars (\$10.00) per month for a pass authorizing travel in one zone, and an additional ten dollars (\$10.00) per month for each additional zone. Such passes may be purchased only through or by the School District or the University of Alaska-Juneau for issuance to and use by full-time students enrolled in an educational program of the sponsoring institution.

F. Experimental rates designed to improve the service and/or utilization of the Capital Transit System may be instituted, if approved by the assembly by motion for a period not to exceed 4 months. The manager shall report to the assembly on the effects of experimental rates in sufficient time to allow the assembly to institute a permanent rate change prior to the end of the 4-month period.

2. Resolutions No. 224, 225, 242, 287 and all other resolutions in conflict herewith are repealed.
