RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE METHOD OF PROVIDING  
RECOGNITION TO CITIZENS FOR CERTAIN VOLUNTARY  
SERVICES TO THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU.

WHEREAS, the city and borough of Juneau, Alaska regularly calls upon its citizens to serve on its assembly, boards, committees, commissions and councils, and

WHEREAS, such citizens serve with little or no monetary compensation, and

WHEREAS, such citizens devote countless and often thankless hours to public service in the discharge of their duties as members of the city and borough assembly, boards, committees, commissions and councils, and

WHEREAS, formal recognition should be given to those who so unselfishly give of their time and talents to serve the city and borough of Juneau;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

1. That a plaque shall be given to each of the following when leaving a position in good standing:

- A. An elected member of the assembly who serves at least one year.
- B. An appointed member of the assembly who serves to the next regular election following appointment.
- C. A member who serves a full term or more on the planning commission, hospital board, personnel board, employee relations board or any board, commission, committee or council which is established by ordinance.

2. That a certificate of appreciation shall be given to each of the following when leaving a position in good standing:

- A. A member of a board, committee, commission or council who serves one or more years.

- B. A member of an ad hoc board who serves until the committee has discharged its duties.
