RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A METHOD FOR PROVIDING
RECOGNITION TO EMPLOYEES FOR CONTINUOUS
SERVICE TO THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU.

WHEREAS, the value to the public of an employee of the city and borough of Juneau increases with the length of continuous service by the employee, and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate to give recognition to employees who have been employed by the city and borough for five or more consecutive years, and

WHEREAS, such recognition should be be given publicly on a regular basis;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

1. That a service pin shall be given to each employee when the employee has attained 5, 10, 15, 20 and 25 consecutive years of service as an employee of the city and borough of Juneau and its predecessors.

2. That an employee who leaves the employment of the city and borough of Juneau in good standing with 3 or more total years of service may receive recognition in the form of a certificate of appreciation.

3. That an employee who leaves employment of the city and borough of Juneau in good standing with 20 or more total years of service may receive recognition in the form of a plaque or other suitable award as determined by the manager.

4. That not less often than annually, the manager shall present the service awards authorized in paragraph 1, 2 and 3 above. Such presentations shall be open to the public and shall be in January unless the manager determines that such awards should be made at a different time. When appropriate, the manager may make awards on an individual basis.
