A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE PERSONNEL RULES  
TO GIVE REEMPLOYMENT PREFERENCE TO PERSONS  
LAID OFF BY REASON OF JOB ABOLITION.

WHEREAS, the assembly of the city and borough of Juneau has, by Resolution No. 176, adopted personnel rules for the municipality, and

WHEREAS, the assembly deems it appropriate to change certain of these rules,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

That the personnel rules adopted by the assembly by Resolution No. 176, as amended, are hereby amended by adding a new Rule 11 04.6 reading as follows:

11 04.6 In the case of a layoff of a permanent employee, by reason of abolition of the position occupied by the employee, such employee on the layoff list shall be given priority for employment in any vacant position for which the employee qualifies. This rule does not apply to positions which are partially exempt under CBJ 44.05.120.
