A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A GRANT FROM THE FEDERAL AVIATION AGENCY IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$102,646 FOR DEVELOPMENT OF A MASTER PLAN FOR THE JUNEAU INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT, PROJECT NO. A-02-0133-01.

WHEREAS, the city and borough of Juneau, Alaska has heretofore submitted an application to the Federal Aviation Agency (FAA) for a grant not to exceed \$102,646 under the Airport and Airway Development Act of 1970 as amended, to aid in the financing of the development of the master plan for the Juneau International Airport identified as FAA Project No. A-02-0133-01 and as City and Borough Public Works Project No. A-29, Airport Planning, and

WHEREAS, the FAA has approved said application, and

WHEREAS, the assembly of the city and borough of Juneau on September 2, 1976 transferred to public works project A-29 the local funds required as a match under said grant, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and in the public interest to develop a master plan for the Juneau International Airport;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

That said agreement, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated as if set out herein is hereby in all respects approved by the assembly of the city and borough of Juneau, and the manager of the city and borough is hereby authorized to execute said agreement and such other documents as are necessary to implement the grant. The manager of the city and borough or his designee or such officer as is required by law or regulation is hereby authorized to do such acts as are required in execution of the grant agreement and the performance of its terms; further, the manager or his designee is authorized to execute such requisitions as may be required for payment from the FAA of funds pursuant to said agreement.
