RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

A RESOLUTION REPEALING RESOLUTION
SERIAL NO. 217 AND ESTABLISHING FEES
FOR THE USE OF THE SWIMMING POOL.

WHEREAS, it is desirable that the fees for the use of the swimming pool as established in Resolution Serial No. 217 be changed,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

1. That for other than public school uses, the following swimming pool rates and conditions are hereby established:

A. Admission Fees.

<u>Swim</u>	<u>Adult</u>	<u>Youth and Senior Citizen</u>
60-minute swims	\$1.00	\$.50
90-minute swims	1.50	.75
25-cent swim	.25	.25

B. Pool Rentals.

<u>Number of Persons in Group</u>	<u>Hourly Rate</u>
0-50	\$30.00
51-100	35.00
100-150	40.00
151-200	45.00

Minimum pool rental fees shall be the fee for one hour at the applicable rate. After the first hour, the fee may be incremented on a quarter hour basis, each quarter hour or part thereof being charged at one-fourth the applicable hourly rate.

C. Swimming Lessons: \$1.25 per hour

D. Monthly Tickets:

Tickets good for one calendar month or any part of a calendar month shall be available at the following rates:

Adult	\$20.00
Youth and Senior Citizen	10.00

Monthly tickets are non-transferable and no refunds for any reason may be made. The manager or his designee may prorate the monthly fee for any month during which there is a planned closure of the swimming pool.

E. Definitions.

"Adult" means a person who is 18 years of age or older.

"Youth" means a person who is less than 18 years of age.

"Senior Citizen" means a person who is 65 years of age or over.

"25-cent swim" is a 90-minute swim on Saturdays, Sundays and holidays at a time fixed by the manager or his designee.

F. Exemptions for Handicapped.

Admission fees may be waived during periods scheduled by the pool manager for persons participating in programs conducted by non-profit organizations where such programs are for handicapped persons.


2. That Resolution No. 155 is hereby repealed.
