RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A LAND
TRANSPORTATION ADVISORY COMMITTEE
FOR THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU.

WHEREAS, the city and borough of Juneau should have an adequate land transportation system for the well-being of the citizens of the municipality, and

WHEREAS, the community as the capital city contains many individuals with expertise in transportation and traffic engineering, and

WHEREAS, these individuals experienced in land transportation could act to advise the assembly regarding transportation and traffic matters to the advantage of the municipality;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

1. That there is created a Land Transportation Advisory Committee for the city and borough of Juneau consisting of seven (7) members appointed by the mayor with the concurrence of the assembly.

2. That members shall serve three (3) year staggered terms beginning on September 1 of the year appointed provided that of those first appointed, two shall serve a one year term and two shall serve a two (2) year term.

3. That the committee shall advise the assembly regarding:

- (a) municipal bus operations including but not limited to fare structure, frequency of operations and routes;
- (b) transportation element of the comprehensive plan; and
- (c) situations in the municipality requiring action to improve safety or mobility insofar as land transportation is concerned.
