A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF LOTS 3, 4, 5 and 6 OF BLOCK 7, U.S. SURVEY NO. 7-A, AMENDED, ADDITION TO THE TOWNSITE OF JUNEAU.

WHEREAS, Alaska Tram has requested the sale of Lots 3, 4, 5 and 6 of Block 7, U.S. Survey7-A, amended, addition to the townsite of Juneau, and

WHEREAS, the planning commission of the City and Borough of Juneau has reviewed the proposed sale and given its approval, and

WHEREAS, it is the interest of the public to make the requested lots available for sale, and

WHEREAS, the municipality should reserve a strip of land 20 feet wide along the southwest boundary of all four lots where they abut South Franklin for future street use and expansion, and

1. That the following described property is hereby declared to be available for sale by sealed bids:

Lots 3, 4, 5 and 6, of Block 7 in U.S. Survey No. 7-A, amended, addition to the townsite of Juneau, lying within the First Judicial District, State of Alaska, excepting therefrom and reserving to the City and Borough of Juneau an easement 20 feet in width lying along the southwest boundary of each of the aforesaid lots, such easement to be for street purposes.

2. That the minimum acceptable bid shall be \$11,415.

3. That the manager or his designee is hereby authorized to take all steps necessary to sell the above described property in accordance with applicable ordinances.

That the manager is authorized to include such additional terms, conditions and reservations as he deems necessary to protect the public interest, provided, however, any restrictions, easements or burdens not specifically set forth in this resolution which cause a significant decrease in value of the property to be sold shall be offset by a corresponding reduction in the purchase price.
