A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING CHARGES
FOR AMBULANCE SERVICES.

WHEREAS, the City and Borough of Juneau provides ambulance services to the public, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to establish a charge for ambulance services,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

1. That the charge for ambulance services shall be Fifty Dollars (\$50) per run. There shall be no charge for materials, supplies or milage.
2. That the ambulance service charge shall be the joint and several liability of the person transported and the person requesting the ambulance service.
3. That the charge shall apply whether transportation is provided or not.
4. That no charge shall be made to a governmental public safety or emergency services agency which requests ambulance services in the discharge of its public safety or emergency duties.
