## RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

## A RESOLUTION CREATING A HOUSING REHABILITATION CITIZENS' COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, the Housing and Community Development Act provides for housing rehabilitation programs, and

WHEREAS, the assembly has approved a local housing rehabilitation program, and

WHRERAS, said plan requires a citizens' committee to perform various functions, and

WHRERAS, the assembly desires to increase citizen participation in the operation of the City and Borough government,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

1. There is established the Juneau Housing Rehabilitation Citizens' Committee.

2. The Committee shall consist of three registered voters of the municipality who shall serve staggered three year terms. The membership shall consist of one person with banking or financial experience, one person with home building experience, and one person of low or moderate income who resides in an affected neighborhood.

3. The Committee shall have the following duties:

(a) Conduct public hearings to consider citizens' suggestions and recommendations concerning the planning and implementation of the housing rehabilitation program.

(b) Recommend to the administration and assembly policies and actions to implement and improve the program.

(c) Evaluate and recommend acceptance or denial of housing rehabilitation applications.

(d) Review and recommend solutions to problems and complaints of house owners under the program relating to rehabilitation work, contracts, loans and similar matters. 4. Staff support for the Committee shall be provided by the Attorney's office for legal matters and by the Manager for such other assistance and support as necessary.
