RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

A RESOLUTION CREATING THE EAGLECREST ADVISORY COMMITTEE.

WHEREAS, public expressions have been made relating to the future method for the management of the Eaglecrest ski area, and

WHEREAS, Eaglecrest should be operated on a self supporting basis, and

WHEREAS, the future development of Eaglecrest will have an impact on various sectors of the economy of the Juneau area, and

WHEREAS, it would be appropriate to establish an advisory committee as a means of exploring various management options, to assist in making Eaglecrest a self supporting operation, and to advise the assembly on management and development matters concerning Eaglecrest,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

- 1. That there is established the Juneau Eagle-crest Advisory Committee which shall meet regularly for the purpose of advising the assembly on matters concerning the operation, management and future development of the Eagle-crest ski area and adjacent property.
- 2. That the committee shall consist of nine residents of the municipality appointed by the assembly for three-year staggered terms except that three of those first appointed shall serve for a one-year term and three shall serve for a two-year term. The committee shall consist not only of persons who are interested in skiing, but also of persons who are involved in various aspects of the tourist industry and other facets of the local economy which would be affected by Eaglecrest management and development policies. The ski area manager shall be an ex officio, non-voting member of the committee. The assembly may also appoint one or more of its members as liaison to the committee.
- 3. The committee shall review the operations, management, budget, development plans and other factors affecting the present and future operation of the Eaglecrest ski area and shall make such recommendations as it deems appropriate to the assembly and to the administration. The

committee shall study alternate methods of management and operation of the area. The committee shall take into account in analyzing the various possibilities the full and true value of Eaglecrest, the amount of local funds invested in the area, the amount of state and federal funds invested in the area, the impact of state and federal grant agreements affecting Eaglecrest on each proposal and the impact of each proposal on a self supporting operation.

4. The committee shall review and comment on the comprehensive development plan for Eaglecrest and adjacent lands.
