A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION SERIAL NO. 210 TO PERMIT THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE DOUGLAS SERVICE AREA ADVISORY BOARD TO CONSIST OF UP TO ELEVEN MEMBERS.

WHEREAS, the Douglas Service Area Advisory Board established under Resolution Serial No. 210 consists of five members, each serving a two-year term, and

WHEREAS, a larger number of members will permit more residents of the Douglas Service Area (No. 2) to participate in the advisory functions of the board and will provide for a better cross-section and the representation of more diverse interests;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

That Section 2 of Resolution Serial No. 210 is amended to read:

2. Such board shall consist of not less than five (5) and not more than eleven (11) members appointed by the Assembly for staggered two-year terms. The initial board shall consist of two members appointed for an initial term of one (1) year, and three members appointed for an initial term of two (2) years. Appointments shall be made for initial terms which will insure, as nearly as possible, that an equal number of terms will expire each year.
