RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

A RESOLUTION REPEALING RESOLUTION SERIAL NO. 549;
ELIMINATING ALL PRESENT TRUCK LOADING ZONES WITHIN
THE JUNEAU SERVICE AREA (NO. 1); AND
ESTABLISHING NEW TRUCK LOADING ZONES.

WHEREAS, CBJ 72.01.130 authorizes the assembly to establish truck loading and bus stop zones by resolution, and

WHEREAS, it was contemplated that the number of truck loading zones would be reduced and changed after the adoption of Ordinance Serial No. 79-29 (CBJ 72.18.025) relating to temporary van loading zones, and

WHEREAS, the assembly and the assembly parking committee have determined that only certain truck loading zones should be established,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

1. That the manager or his designee is authorized to post a reasonable portion of the northerly side of Fourth Street between Main and Seward Streets for commercial truck loading only and to establish and post on the same side of said street a bus stop zone; and that, unless determined otherwise by the manager or his designee, there should be no parking, standing or stopping on either side of said block except for authorized bus and truck loading.

2. That the manager or his designee is authorized and directed to post a reasonable portion of the following areas for commercial truck loading only:

- (a) On Seward Street south of Second Street.
- (b) On Third Street east of Franklin Street.
- (c) On Franklin Street in front of the Baranof Hotel.


3. That the manager or his designee is authorized to post a reasonable portion of the westerly side of Seward Street south of Fourth Street for service vehicle parking.

4. That all truck loading zones in the Juneau Service Area (No. 1) not set forth above shall be eliminated and such space be made available for public parking or such other uses or reservations as are authorized and deemed necessary by the manager or his designee.
